Start a career as a Certified Apartment Maintenance Technician (CAMT)!

Apartment Maintenance Technicians perform installation, repair, and upkeep tasks in an apartment complex, such as repairing air conditioners, fixing electrical switches, replacing machine parts, painting walls, etc.

Students will learn about:

- the apartment business
- HVAC
- plumbing
- appliance maintenance and repair
- maintenance and repair of the interior and exterior of properties

After successfully completing the program, students will receive a provisional certificate from the National Apartment Association Education Institute (NAAEI) and will be eligible for a certificate from the NAAEI upon completing one year of field work. This program is **one of CCBC's most successful programs for job placement** and includes extensive hands-on laboratory work. No high school diploma is required.
